



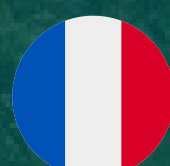

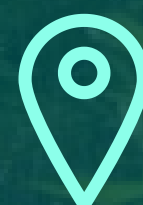

Location

Burg Tannroda, nestled in the scenic countryside near Bad Berka in Thuringia, Germany, is a hidden gem steeped in **medieval charm and history**. Surrounded by rolling hills and lush forests, this historic castle offers a glimpse into the region's storied past while providing a tranquil retreat into nature.



Objectives

- Equip young people with practical knowledge and skills in sustainable farming and soil protection.
- Foster international collaboration and peer-to-peer learning by bringing together youth from Germany and France.
- Empower young people as community leaders by giving them the tools and confidence to initiate and sustain their own environmental projects.



Participants

The Activating Youth in Sustainable Farming and Soil Protection project aims to empower young people aged 17–30 from Germany and France by equipping them with the knowledge, skills, and resources needed to engage in sustainable farming and soil protection.

The project also provides participants with the space, mentorship and opportunities to implement initiatives in their communities.

- There will be 16 young participants, aged 17 to 30, from France and Germany. With an interest in soil protection and sustainable farming.

Accommodation at Castle Tannroda

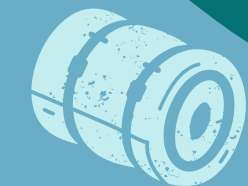
Participants will be sleeping in **tents** shared max by two people.

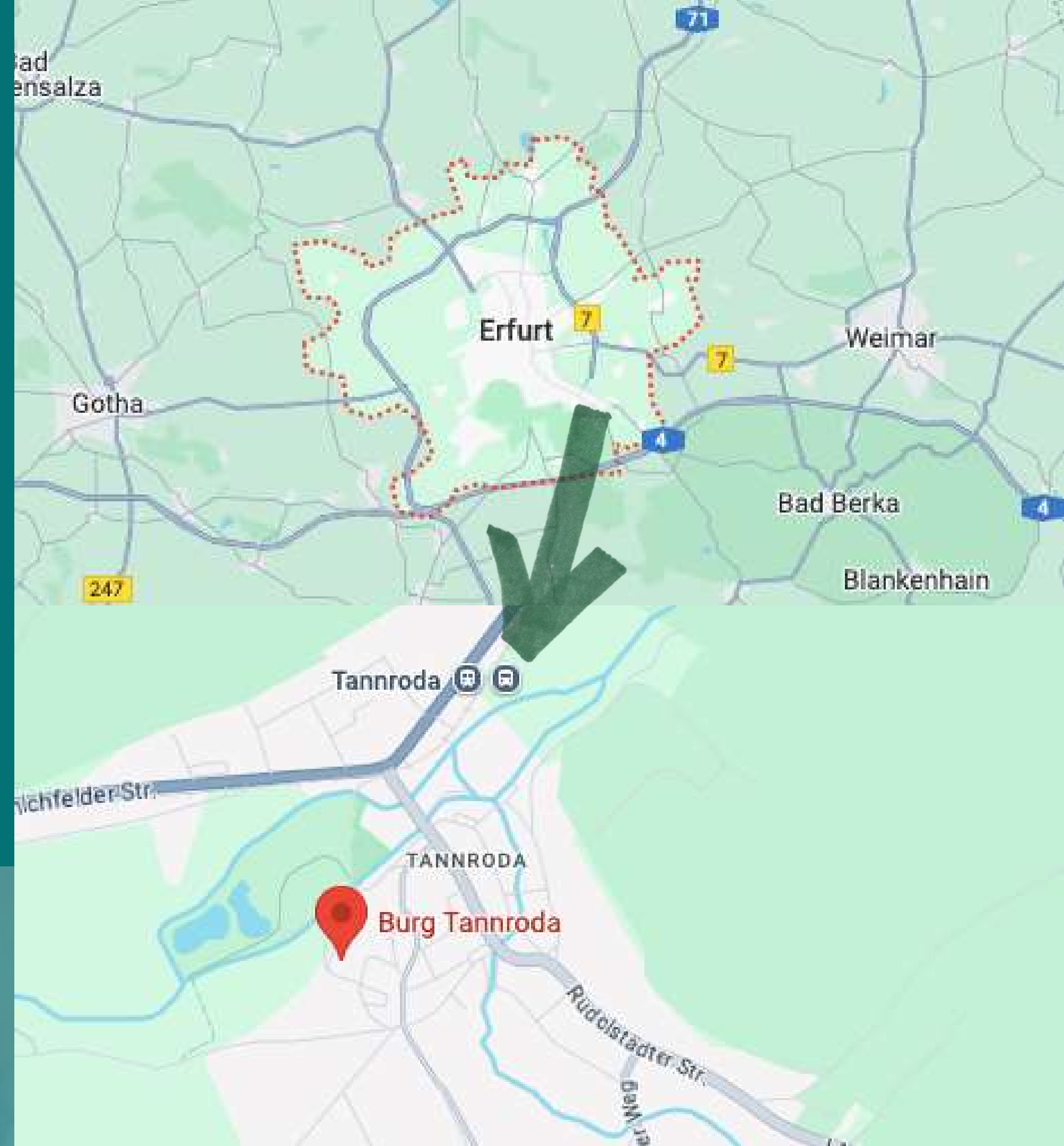
